A. NATURE & SCOPE

Urban Outdoor Youth Leaders introduce kids to the best outdoor activities within the city limits! Through cycling, wall climbing, rafting, swimming, canoeing and many other fun activities, we get youth active and outside! This position is responsible for providing a fun, safe, and healthy environment for children (grades 1-8) registered in our summer outdoor programs. Urban Outdoor Youth Leaders are required to supervise children and implement weekly activities for a variety of different day-camps. Leaders will report to the Youth Program Coordinator and will be required to work from the end of June to the end of August. If you want to spend your summer outside floating down the river on a raft, biking, swimming, and climbing with a group of kids, this position is for you!

B. CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Enthusiasm for working with young people in the outdoors, rain or shine
- Meet and greet parents and campers on arrival and departure from camp
- Implement all aspects of the daily schedule
- Provide quality care, fun, and supervision to all campers
- Participate in all group activities and encourage camper participation. Activities include (but not exclusive to): cycling, wall climbing, rafting on the Bow River, swimming, canoeing and hiking.
- Provide first aid care when necessary and notify the Youth Program Coordinator of actions
- Provide weekly written reports to Youth Program Coordinator
- Abide by the Outdoor Centre's Policies and Procedures

- A bicycle in good working condition is required
- Must be available and willing to work Monday to Friday from 7:30am to 5:00pm (hours vary)

- Valid (or intent to get) police information check for the vulnerable sector
