

Urban Outdoor Youth Leader: Cycling Instructor

A. NATURE & SCOPE

If you want to spend your summer outside teaching young people the basics about urban cycling, pathway etiquette, bike maintenance, and more, then this position is for you! We are looking for a passionate educator, outdoor enthusiast, and avid urban cyclist. This position will be responsible for taking the lead on our Tour de Calgary camp for youth in grades 2-8. Each week they will be exploring new locations around Calgary by bike! Instructors are required to supervise children and implement weekly activities for most of our biking camps within urban settings. Instructors will be given the camp manuals in advance and training prior to running the camp. Instructors will also be asked to participate as an educator in our staff training. Instructors report to the Youth Program Coordinators and will be required to work for the duration of the dates listed above.

B. CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Enthusiasm for working with young people in the outdoors
- Meet and greet guardians and campers on arrival and departure from camp
- Implement all aspects of the daily schedule
- Provide quality care, fun, and supervision to all campers
- Participate in all group activities and encourage camper participation. Activities include (but not exclusive to): cycling, wall climbing, rafting on the Bow River, swimming, and hiking
- Provide first aid care when necessary and notify the Youth Program Coordinators of actions
- Provide weekly written reports to Youth Program Coordinators
- Abide by the Outdoor Centre's Policies and Procedures

C. QUALIFICATIONS

- General knowledge and experience of outdoor activities and city pathways around Calgary
- Must be available and willing to work Monday to Friday from 8:00am to 4:30pm
- To be available for staff training dates
- Experience and/or educational training working with youth (ages 5-18)
- Valid (or intent to get) Standard First Aid and CPR
- Valid (or intent to get) security clearance check for the vulnerable sector
