

## Summer Climbing Instructor

### A. NATURE & SCOPE

If you want to spend your summer teaching wall climbing and bouldering to kids, this position is for you! We are looking for a passionate educator and avid climber. This position will be responsible for teaching basic climbing lessons to our camp participants in Grades 2-8 as well as working in the climbing office where successful candidates will interact with Outdoor Centre clients, check-in climbers for open recreation hours, and perform belay tests/gym-orientation when needed. Instructors are required to supervise children and implement lesson plans, activities, and games as well as follow policies and procedures to ensure a safe environment. Instructors will report to both the Youth Program Coordinators as well as the Outdoor Centre Manager.

### B. CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Enthusiasm for working with young people in an active and dynamic environment
- Create and implement lesson plans for a variety of ages and skill levels
- Assist in camp staff training/orientation of the climbing wall
- Provide quality care, fun, and supervision to all participants
- Provide first aid care when necessary and notify the Youth Program Coordinators and Outdoor Centre Manager of actions
- Provide weekly written reports to Youth Program Coordinators and Outdoor Centre Manager
- Abide by the Outdoor Centre's Policies and Procedures
- Competency in delivering and recording accurate belay tests and safety checks
- Provide clients with facility orientation
- Use of Active Living Client Services Information System (CSIS) to record facility usage during non-program hours

### C. QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience and knowledge wall climbing and bouldering
- Must be available and willing to work Monday to Friday between 9:00AM-5:00PM
- Experience and/or educational training working with youth (ages 5-18)
- Valid (or intent to get) Standard First Aid & CPR. This can be offered at a subsidized rate.
- Police Check for the Vulnerable Sector. This will be reimbursed at the end of the contract.
- Climbing Gym Instructor (CGI) certification is considered an asset.
