The Lifeguard/Instructor duties include, but are not limited to:

Acting as an instructor and lifeguard in addition to assisting with the maintenance and operations of the facility year-round. You will be required to attend all in-service training sessions and maintain your skills and knowledge achieved both through formal certification and on the job training. It is your responsibility to ensure that your awards are current as outlined by the University of Calgary Aquatic Centre's Policy and Procedures Manual.

UCalgary Lifeguard/Swim Instructors are required to teach 1 complete set of swim lessons per year to maintain active status.

Qualifications:

- National Lifeguard – current within 2 years
- Lifesaving & Swim Instructor – current within 2 years
- Intermediate First Aid – current within 2 years
- CPR-C/AED – current within 1 year

- Cover Letter
- Lifesaving member ID, and a copy of any non-Lifesaving Society awards
- Three professional or personal references
- Criminal Record Check (with Vulnerable Sector) – must have record of a request being made by the date of application
