- interested in trying martial arts, fencing or golf
- just starting Kindergarten or are entering Grade One
- dancers or want to learn more about drama & theatre
- game to try something new or learn more about what they like
- interested in dinosaurs, fantasy worlds, making comic books and gaming
- creative kids that want to build with LEGO®, draw, paint, sculpt and make digital art
- curious about sciences like biology, chemistry, physics, criminal science and medicine

At Mini University, we work year-round to plan summer camps that integrate a wide variety of physical activities & games that promote a healthy active lifestyle. All of our camps are scheduled with a variety of hands-on activities that are planned beforehand and instructed by our instructors and leaders. Staff will also get to play some fun lifeguard-led games in the pool with their camps at our indoor Aquatic Centre and go to the Gymnastics Centre every week.

General Instructor & Leader Responsibilities:

- Prepared every day to lead activities with youth both indoors and outdoors
- Ensure the enjoyment and safety of campers throughout each week of camp
- Provide quality supervision and care to all campers. There will be a maximum of 14 campers in each camp and you will work with a different Camp Instructor or Camp Leader each week
- Plan and work collaboratively as a team player with supervisors and other staff
- Participate in all of the camp activities and encourage campers to participate. Every week you will play fun lifeguard-led games in the pool and do gymnastics with your campers
- Engage with parents at Sign-in/out and tell them how their child's day was
- Implement group management strategies when necessary
- Provide first aid care and complete incident reports when necessary
- Complete Daily Field Level Hazard Assessment forms to assess risks and have a plan

- Use the Attendance Sheets every day and review the participants Medical Forms
- Help with daily camp tasks including late drop-off and early pick-up, delivering supplies, and helping set-up/take down larger camp activities such as Before and After Care
- Abide by the UCalgary Summer Camp Policies & Procedures

Specific Instructor Responsibilities:

- Plan and instruct around 8 75-minute activity blocks each week based on the theme of your camp. You don't have to be an expert with lots of experience in your area
- Create new lesson plans and bring back classic activities that campers always love
- Create a comprehensive list of supplies you will be using for the summer
- Participate in all of the Camp Leader-led activities and work together as a team

Specific Leader Responsibilities:

- Plan and instruct two 75-minute sessions of games & activities every day
- Participate in the Instructor-led activities while working together as a team and helping out
- Take the lead on the 15-minute body breaks throughout the day which include using the washroom, filling up water bottles and eating a snack or two

Recommended Qualifications:

- Available to work in July & August, Monday to Friday between 7:45 am to 4:45 pm
 - 8-hour shifts within this time frame depending on the camp each week
- Some experience and an interest in working with kids and youth
- Strong interpersonal communication and teamwork skills
- Organizational skills, with the ability to be flexible and prioritize tasks
- Standard First Aid & CPR Level C and a valid Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Search (successful candidates will acquire these at no cost via Mini University)
- Available to attend two days of Staff Training at the end of June before camp starts
