The ideal candidates will have experience working with children, a passion for racquet sports.

CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend pre-camp training sessions to learn about camp policies, procedures, and emergency protocols.
- Assist in lesson planning and organizing the camp program. Develop and lead age-appropriate activities, and games.
- Work collaboratively with other camp leaders. Participate in staff meetings and contribute to planning.
- Serve as a positive role model for campers by demonstrating appropriate behavior. Encourage and foster a positive and inclusive camp environment. Provide leadership and guidance to campers in both group and individual settings.
- Always ensure the safety of campers. Implement and enforce camp safety rules and emergency procedures.
- Communicate effectively with campers, parents, and camp leaders. Address and resolve conflicts among campers, if necessary.
- Assist with camper check-in and check-out procedures. Help with setting up and breaking down camp facilities. Ensure that equipment and supplies are properly maintained and safe to use.
- Keep accurate records of camper attendance, incidents, and achievements.
